



## 2023 Cirillo Barossa Shiraz



The Cirillo Shiraz is made with grapes sourced from estate grown vineyards in Light Pass. The vine ages vary from 1848-year-old to 1998 plantings.

With open fermentation, natural yeast, basket pressed and then matured in seasoned French and American oak for 12 months.

The colour is dark purple in appearance. It displays earthy spice driven aromas, with hints of berry fruits, mocha and cherry. Soft and delicate on the palate, typical of shiraz from this region. There is a generosity but with poise and restraint. A beautifully fragrant and pretty wine.

It carries mid-palate weight, with a lengthy finish that lingers in the mouth for some time. This wine can be enjoyed now or over the next decade or two.
